DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITIES: A Call for Nominations for the Hetherington Award was included in the first AAKPE Newsletter following the Annual Meeting with information concerning eligibility and deadlines for nominations. A list of previous Hetherington Award winners was also included in this Newsletter. One nomination was submitted by the March 1, 2010 deadline and the curriculum vita of this nominee was sent to all members of the Standing Committee on Awards before March 15. The voting deadline was April 1 and all Committee Members supported the nominee by voting “yes.” Jack Wilmore (Fellow #252) was chosen as the 2010 recipient of the Hetherington Award.

ACTION ITEMS: According to the Operating Code for the Standing Committee on Awards the Secretary-Treasurer shall provide the Committee Chairperson a list of those retired Fellows who retain Active or Emeritus status as listed in the current Membership Directory. To procure nominations the Chairperson of the Committee shall send a form for nominating candidates for the Hetherington Award to the AAKPE Newsletter Editor for inclusion in the first AAKPE Newsletter following the Annual Meeting. It also indicates that a list of previous Hetherington Award winners shall be included in this AAKPE Newsletter. I did not receive a list of retired Fellows who retain Active or Emeritus status and according to the information I received from Kim Scott we have not used a form since before 1998. Usually there is a “call for nominees” in the Newsletter. However, Kim created a form for this year.

CHANGES TO OPERATION CODE: The procedure for Procurement of Nominations should be revised if a “call for nominations” is to be used rather than a form. If the form is the correct procedure then it needs to be approved and made available.
